- 1. Meeting was called to order at 6:30 by Trevor.
- 2. Minutes – from 08/03/2026 were approved Dave/Hugh AIF
- 3. Adoption/Amendments to Agenda – none
- 4. New Business –

A. Possible House & Land Donation – Diane explained that Dave Driscoll owns property on Tice Mill Road and is interested in donating the house and two acres to the Town. Dave was not on Zoom as anticipated, so a discussion regarding possibilities ensued. The Board really doesn't want to take on an older building that would need upkeep/maintenance. Trevor suggested asking Mr. Driscoll if he would be interested in selling and donating the proceeds to the Town. Diane will speak with him.

B. Road Foreman Report – A culvert near Trucott Road on Valley Road needs to be changed as it has failed. It is anticipated that the work will be done this Thursday, as soon as the end of Valley Road can be accessed. Jason Patenaude will be doing the work. The change will only take one day. Bates Hill Road project should be done in September. The backhoe had relief valves changed, still needs more work. It is better, but not great. The mower lost its brakes and is at Larry Morin's shop.

C. Grants In Aid FY27- Reviewed grant - \$11,000 with an in-kind match of \$2,750. Trevor moved to accept, 2nd by Dave AIF.

D. Holland Unity Center Update - Kenric shared that he had waxed two small floors but has been unable to arrange to use the Jr High's floor machine. Due to timing with people in and out of the building, it was decided to put off floor waxing until next year. Food shelf folks are still in the building at random hours. Fire extinguishers have all been checked as well as the kitchen suppression system.

5. Public Comment – The Holland Community Center's Bingo was not well attended. The Holland Historical Society will be having a Vendor/yard sale event this Saturday at the Unity Center from 9-2. The Holland Community Center folks will be there grilling and selling burgers. Liz asked about the Twin Bridge job. The work has been pushed back one week and is now expected to start on August 31.
